The candidate must be able to successfully assume academic leadership in one of the following core areas of our Curriculum Structure: Design and Environment, Building Technology, History and Theory, and Architectural Communication and Skills. A good record of research and internationally recognised publications in the areas of his/her specialisation. Must be able to assume an academic leadership role in the Department. Registration with the Namibia Council for Architects and Quantity Surveyors or another similarly recognised relevant statutory professional body within the Southern sub-region is a requirement.

SENIOR LECTURER: ARCHITECTURE (3 POSTS)

A M.Arch. and B.Arch. with six years of lecturing experience or an equivalent combination of relevant professional experience.
