NEED FOR THE CONFERENCE

The various views on education and the dearth of facilities and infrastructure to achieve its goals are only a tip of the iceberg. Perhaps, more frustrating is the challenge of the existing and currently proposed educational buildings and infrastructure not being able to meet the challenges of contemporary educational goals. Many of the existing buildings (and, annoyingly the proposed ones in the works) are dull, drab, uninviting, mostly non-functional and unimpressive to the climate and needs of staff and students.

This then is the need for this conference. If the past must be used as prologue, all stakeholders must dedicatedly address the issues of location, design, construction, furnishing, maintenance, etc. of educational buildings. One of the major problems of these institutions is the inadequacy and or non-availability of necessary and very unavoidable infrastructure such as roads, energy, water, waste collection, dedicated spaces for relaxation and many more.

These are the concerns of this conference. While each of these is enough as a conference theme in itself, this first conference is decidedly holistic to aggregate thoughts and map out a possible path for each and all stakeholders.

GOAL AND OBJECTIVES

Thus, the primary goal of the conference is to provide a forum for a diverse range of leading stakeholders (governmental and non-governmental) to voice their expert opinions, proposals, analysis and aspirations and map out a sustainable future for educational buildings and infrastructure delivery in Nigeria.

Six objectives have been evolved to achieve the stated aim and these are to:

- Describe and analyse the forms and functions of educational buildings and the attending infrastructure in Nigeria's educational system;
- Assess Nigeria's educational infrastructure investment and identify barriers and challenges to the provision of a sustainable, high-quality educational buildings and facilities;
- Establish a framework for multidisciplinary, inter-professionalism and institutional collaboration among stakeholders involved in educational infrastructure provision;

- Engender critical inter-sectoral debate to determine the place of educational infrastructure in the national sustainable development agenda and their effects on educational performance in the country;
- Showcase new innovative concepts in the building/construction sector and how to apply such innovations to new as well as existing educational infrastructure;
- Create action plans to follow-up on outcomes of the conference and reinforce partnerships.

EXPECTED PARTICIPANTS

Educational Institutions: Research institutes, universities, polytechnics, monotronics, colleges of education, nursery and primary schools, secondary schools, etc.

Ministers of Education: A significant number of states' commissioners of education are expected to join the Conference. Ministers of related ministries including finance and works will be invited to join the high-level debate with other professionals. The Ministers are also expected to discuss and adopt the high-level statement that will be a key output of the Conference.

CALL FOR PAPERS

The SEBIN 2016 organizing committee welcomes papers on all topics related to sustainable educational buildings and infrastructure provision and, especially, for the following sub-themes:

- i. Strategies and Frameworks for the Delivery of the Sustainable Educational Buildings and Infrastructure.
- ii. Educational Building and Infrastructure Development Concepts.
- iii. Actor Collaboration in Sustainable Educational Building and Infrastructure.
- iv. Methods and Tools for Sustainability in the Educational Building and Infrastructure Sector.
- v. Research on Material and Product Innovation.
- vi. Infrastructure Necessary for Incorporating ICT innovations into the Education System.

Proposals for papers on the conference sub-themes are invited from all sectors of the field, and will be evaluated competitively by anonymous referees. If revisions are required, authors will be notified prior to the conference date.

Accepted papers will be scheduled for interactive paper sessions and panels. Paper sessions include at least 4 presentations and a moderator. An interactive poster session is included in a plenary; requires visual representation of research; and promotes small group or one-on-one discussions.

All submissions must be completed online on or before 23:00 GMT, 15 May

2016. To avoid technical problems, early submission is strongly encouraged. The conference submission website will go online around 1 April 2016.
